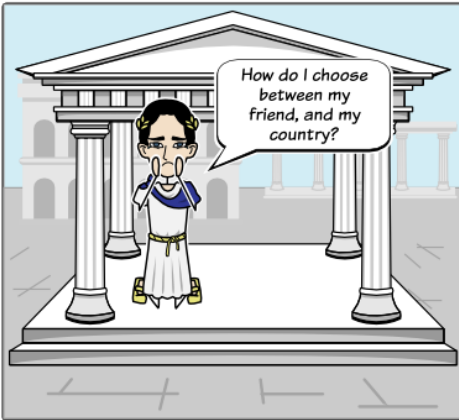


The Tragedy of Julius Caesar Tragic Hero Brutus

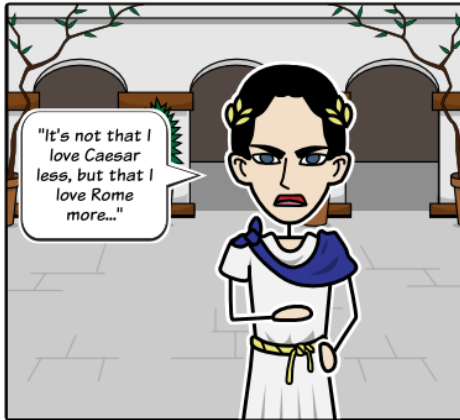

HAMARTIA

HUBRIS

PERIPETEIA

ANAGNORISIS

NEMESIS

CATHARSIS



Antony finds Brutus' body and requests that he be buried as a hero. The audience is sad that a noble man, with good intentions, suffered such a tragic fate.
